I refer to your application in which you requested advice on Aboriginal cultural heritage places recorded on the above location.

The Cultural Heritage Database and Register search has been completed and I would like to advise that no Aboriginal cultural heritage is currently recorded in your specific search area, from the data provided by you. However, it is probable that the absence of recorded Aboriginal cultural heritage places reflects a lack of previous cultural heritage surveys of the area. Therefore, our records are not likely to reflect a true picture of the Aboriginal cultural heritage values of the area.

I note that, pursuant to the Cultural Heritage Duty of Care Guidelines, you have advised that the proposed activity is a 'Category 5 activity'. As such, I take this opportunity to remind you that in accordance with those Guidelines:-

Where an activity is proposed under category 5 there is generally a high risk that it could harm Aboriginal cultural heritage. In these circumstances, the activity should not proceed without cultural heritage assessment.

Where an activity is proposed under category 5, it is necessary to notify the Aboriginal Party and seek: (a) Advice as to whether the feature constitutes Aboriginal cultural heritage; and

(b) If it does, agreement as to how best the activity may be managed to avoid or minimise harm to any Aboriginal cultural heritage.

I remind you also that the extent to which the person has complied with Cultural Heritage Duty of Care Guidelines and the extent to which the person consulted with Aboriginal parties about the carrying out of the activity, and the results of the consultation are factors a court may consider when determining if a party has complied with the duty of care.

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing in relation to the Proposed Road Closure on Redding Road near Dalby. As per the Application for Closure of Road document, it is described as:

"An area of about 1.79 Hectares being part of Redding Road adjoining the western boundary of Lot 1 on RP110046 (parish of Myall, locality of Dalby) and shown as permanent road closure on Drawing No: DD2014/008."

I am writing on behalf of McVeigh Partnership Trust who farms country in the dalby, jimbour and macalister areas. I would like to respectfully object to the proposed permanent closure of the road as we utilise this facility, as required and quite often to move heavy and oversized farming machinery from farm to farm and to avoid the busy roads close to Dalby. Closure of this road would require driving these oversized and heavy farm machines and implements on both the Moonie Highway, Warrego Highway and Jandowae Rd which would pose a significant risk to staff and drivers of heavy equipment, not to mention the significant dangers to motorists on these roads. There has been a substantial increase in traffic on all above said routes, further increasing the risks to ourselves and other motorists should the road closure take place.

We appreciate the use of private farm roadways to access Redding Rd for many of the reasons highlighted above. As we move equipment from property to property, and use connecting roads to Redding Rd to avoid traffic and risks to operators and other motorists on the busy sections of the Moonie and Warrego Highways. It should be noted also that these sections of the highway are the busiest sections due to their proximity to the township of Dalby. The sections of highway we will have to take, should Redding Rd be closed, are on the fringe of town where the density of traffic is at its highest with the exception of being in the township itself.

I trust the reasons for objection demonstrate the need for Redding Rd to remain open for the safety of all those in the area and traveling on these roads.
