Callide Mine has conducted a review of the Incident Reporting & investigation process used at the operation and with respect to the directive issued on the 11/01/2011.

"The SSE must review the adequacy of that part of the Safety & Health Management System concerning the management of incidents, identify the appropriate corrective actions that are required to ensure compliance with reporting requirements and implement those corrective actions."

Below is a list of findings from the review conducted for the Incident Reporting Process (IRP) and in conjunction with a review of the site Emergency Management Plan (EMP).

 IRP states that the SSHR is required to be notified for any injury / illness or HPI. The EMP did not cover this in its duty card notifications.

Action taken: The IRP has been updated to reflect the notification to the SSHR for all MTC and LTI or HPI. The EMP has been updated to align with the IRP for the notification of any MTC and LTI or HPI.

2. Roles and Responsibilities in the IRP details that the Safety and Health Manager must ensure all external reporting requirements are carried out within designated timeframes. The EMP details this is a requirement of the SSE or delegate.

Action taken: The IRP has been updated to ensure the SSE or delegate has this responsibility.

EMP flowchart details that notification to the DME, ISHR, SSHR is to be completed immediately. IRP details that HPI's are to be notified to the DME and ISHR immediately in the "action column" but the "timing column" states ASAP

Action taken: The "timing column" of the IRP has been updated to align with the "action column" of the IRP and the EMP to read "immediately". A definition of "immediately" has been place into the definitions section of both the EMP and IRP.

The purpose of this MRE is to provide a record of my verbal directive to Acting SSE levant information s.73 Irrelevant information on 10/1/11 at about 4.30pm persuant to the CMS&H Act s.169, to suspend operations at the mine for an ineffective safety and Health Management System.

169. Directive to suspend operations for ineffective safety and health management system If an inspector believes there is not an effective safety and health management system for a coal mine or part of a coal mine, the inspector may give a directive suspending operations in all or part of the mine.

## Background:

An accident/High Potential Incident occurred yesterday, 10 January 2011 at about 2pm, in the Boundary Hill section of the mine. One Hitachi Rear Dump Truck ran into the rear of another similar truck resulting in significant damage to the truck cabin and the operator being pinned by the legs and unable to exit the vehicle. The operator was subsequently extricated from the vehicle and although it was reported that there did not appear to be significant injury, was airlifted to Rockhampton Hospital for thorough examination at about 4.30pm.

At about 4pm the Mines Inspectorate in Rockhampton became aware of the incident due to it's having been reported in the media. At 4.08pm I contacted SSEs.73 Irrelevant information provided basic information about the incident. He advised that he was in Rockhampton and thatelevant information s.73 Irrelevant information fact the acting SSE and undertook to phone Callide Mine and have someone phone me. That did not occur however at about 4.18pm.73 Irrelevant information for the incident to Inspector Bill Taylor. Inspector Taylor will inspect the incident site today 11/1/11 and will make enquiry as to what provisions are made in the mines Safety Management System with respect to the management of incidents and in particular the reporting of High Potential Incidents in compliance with the relevant legislation ie. CMS&H Act s.198:-

## 198. Notice of accidents, incidents, deaths or diseases

- (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), as soon as practicable after becoming aware of a serious accident, high potential incident or a death at a coal mine, the site senior executive for the coal mine must notify an inspector and an industry safety and health representative about the accident, incident or death either orally or by notice.
- (2) Subsection (3) applies to—
