Morning Debbie-Jo,

Following on from our phone conversation this morning please find below some dot points on the current progress of the Waratah Environmental Management Plan (EM Plan):

- 22 July 2015 – Waratah submitted a draft EM Plan to review to determine if content requirements were met;
- 19 August – EHP determined that the draft EM Plan does not yet meet content requirements. EHP provided comments and recommendations to Waratah advising of the additional information that needed to be included in the EM Plan to meet content requirements. EHP recommended that Waratah re-submit the draft EM Plan for a subsequent pre-lodgement review to ensure that all the issues have been addressed prior to formal submission.

The additional information that is required to be included should be available within the EIS documents and other reports undertaken by the applicant. There were no major issues identified that we would consider as being able to hold up the process.

Based on our conversation, it seems a bit early for Waratah to be requesting an extension from the 30 October to 31 December 2015.
