The following is a statement of public interest to support the application to renew EPC 1245 for a second term. The public interest will be positively served by the renewal of this EPC and there are many tangible positive impacts to be considered in assessing this application.

The renewal of this EPC serves the public interest by facilitating the identification and delineation of valuable state owned resources. In the previous term, Ambre conducted a regional scale drilling program which has identified a significant resource within both EPC 1810 and EPC 1245. This resource, named the Mt Molar resource by the company, was measured by an independent geological consultancy to contain 303Mt of JORC compliant coal at 40% ash content as well as 1.2Bt of inventory coal.

Renewal of the EPC will provide data and information as an input to informed decision making. It can inform the future Statutory Regional Planning process through the provision of information on sub-soil conditions, hydrogeological and resource data.

Ambre is aware of the need to sustainably manage landholder relations so underground water flow rates and quality analysis has been provided to landholders for all holes drilled in EPC 1245. In some cases, Ambre have partnered with local drilling contractors in providing waterbores in addition to our exploration boreholes. By offering generous compensation, excellent drill site rehabilitation and a committed landholder relations team, Ambre personnel have been told by many landholders that our drilling operations are welcome to return.

Ambre have opened a community office in the nearby town of Pittsworth to act as a centre where the local community can voice concerns and receive relevant information regarding our activities. This office has given Ambre a presence in the area and this has been supported by Ambre employees taking positions within local community organisations. In addition, renewal of this EPC will enable continuation of support to the community through employment of local workers, continuation of scholarships to local students and sponsorship of local community events and charities.

Renewal of the EPC will have no negative effect upon existing land uses or activities.

We fully understand that the EPC does not confer or imply any further development rights.
