# OBJECTIONS TO PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE (No 06) 2014

1. This notice may be cited as the Objections to Proposed Road Closure Notice (No 06) 2014.

#### Application for road closure [s.100 of the Act]

Applications have been made for the permanent closure of the roads mentioned in the Schedule.

## **Objections**

- 3.(1) An objection (in writing) to a proposed road closure mentioned in the Schedule may be lodged with the Regional Service Director, Department of Natural Resources and Mines, at the regional office for the region in which the road is situated.


