I continued my investigation this morning with Mick Pass (BMA CMW) who was the offsider on the bolter yesterday. I did not get the opportunity to talk with him yesterday as he went to hospital with the injured CMW.

Mick stated that the event occurred as follows;

The CMW was using the bolter to push up the Heusker mesh to get it to go over the head an the installed bolt. The edge of the mesh has a wire rope inserted and the dolly was pushing on the rope area when it slipped off and the leg extended quickly.

The pinning of the mesh has been completed but the mine will continue to review the process of using the bolter to push the mesh up in this manner.

The injured CMW has been taken to Rockhampton for further treatment
